### **Conference Venue**

The conference will be held at the Waterloo Inn and Conference Hotel, 475 King Street North, Waterloo, Ontario. ### **Transportation**

The hotel is easily accessible from Highways 401 and 8/85. Kitchener Waterloo is serviced by three airports:

- Region of Waterloo Airport (YKF): daily flights from Calgary (WestJet) and Ottawa (Bearskin)
- Hamilton International Airport (YHM): daily flights from eastern and western Canada (Westjet)
- Pearson International Airport (YYZ): daily flights from eastern and western Canada (Westjet and Air Canada)
